Antalis and the European REACH regulation (European regulation n° 1907/2006/CE)

The European Regulation n° 1907/2006 regarding the Recording, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Hazardous substances (the “**REACH Regulation**”) came into effect on 1st June 2007.

It provides that all chemical substances that are produced in amounts greater than one tonne per year, may only be marketed within the European Union if they have already been pre-registered or registered.

Antalis, as a distributor, does not have any pre-registering or registering obligation pursuant to the REACH Regulation.

Antalis works closely with its suppliers as follows:

- Antalis asks its suppliers to report if any substance of the latest candidate list of Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation (last extension November 2024) is present in a product delivered to Antalis in a concentration superior to 0.1% of the total weight of the product, and to provide mandatory related information ;
- Antalis asks its suppliers to notify Antalis of any change in the product specificities that could modify a product's status pursuant to the REACH Regulation.

The list of these products and related details are provided to our customers upon request on the basis of our supplier's declaration.

**Substances of very high concern (SVHC) covered by the REACH Regulation (Annex XIV) include the following categories of substances: carcinogens, mutagens or toxic to reproduction (CRM category 1 or 2), persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) or very persistent and very bioaccumulative (vPvB) or for which there is evidence for similar concern.*
